# Moffat County Fair BBQ Cook-Off

## Friday, August 13, 2010

Sign up Deadline is Friday, August 13th, 12:00 Noon

1. This BBQ Cook-off is for meat only. Classes will be for Open entries and Business entries.
2. There will be no fee for entry.
3. Teams can register at the Moffat County Extension Office or at the Fairgrounds Covered picnic Area Friday by noon. Registration forms are available online at [moffatcountyfair.com](http://moffatcountyfair.com) or at the Extension Office. Registration will end Friday, August 13, 12:00 Noon. Competitors must be at least 18 years of age.

Check in will be at 12:00 p.m., August 13th, at the Moffat County Fairgrounds Covered Picnic Area.

At this time, each team will be assigned a confidential number and a space to set up. If 12:00 p.m. does not allow for adequate cooking time, special arrangements can be made prior.

Vehicles will be allowed to unload near the picnic area but must be parked elsewhere.

Teams are required to provide the following:

- Your own heat source (grill, smoker, etc. Absolutely NO pits will be dug.)
  - At least 25 pounds of meat. Meat cannot be precooked. No live animals.
  - Fire extinguisher, recommended.
  - Coolers, cooking utensils, water, trays, etc.
  - 1 table to serve from.
  - Decorations, if desired.
8. Cooking can only take place in designated space. No campers will be allowed.
  9. A People's Choice will be awarded.
  10. Public serving will begin at 5:00 p.m. The public will pay for a plate and receive one voting ticket per plate. The ticket can be placed in the box representing the team they choose. Public voting will end at 6:30 p.m.
  11. Winners will be announced following the cook-off. Serving will take place until 6:30 p.m. or until a team runs out of their entree.
  12. Teams must clean up their space by 7:30 p.m.
  13. No pets during competition.

14. \*\*\*No team is allowed to have/bring/serve alcohol on premises. If evidence of such is determined, the team may be disqualified from competition.

The Moffat County Fair Board will provide the following: plates, utensils, napkins, chips, rolls, beans and drinks.

Most importantly, this competition is for fun. We expect teams to have a good time and display good sportsmanship while exhibiting responsible behavior. This is our 4<sup>th</sup> annual cook off. It is a growing success.

Special Note: For planning purposes each team will provide samples to judges *and* the public.

# **Moffat County Fair Dessert Cook-Off**

## **Friday, August 13, 2010**

**Sign up deadline is Friday, August 13, 12:00 Noon**

You may enter any type of dessert. There will not be different categories for the desserts. All of the dessert entries will be competing against each other.

Competitors must be at least 18 years of age.

There will be no fee for entry.

Participants can register at the Moffat County Extension Office. Registration forms are available online at [moffatcountyfair.com](http://moffatcountyfair.com) or at the Extension Office. Registration will end Friday, August 13, 12:00 Noon.

All desserts should be fully prepared at home and brought to the Moffat County Fairgrounds Covered Picnic Area by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, August 13.

If needed, participant must provide way to keep dessert warm or cold during judging process.

You are encouraged to decorate your dessert, but remember that too many toppings will detract from the presentation and the taste.

Contestants are responsible for providing their own serving utensils.

Each entry should be accompanied by a list of ingredients. Cook-off staff will label desserts with information supplied by the contestants.

Each contestant must cook enough dessert to serve a minimum of 12 people.

Desserts will be divided into small servings for public sampling.

Each contestant will receive a confidential number to correspond with the number on their dessert entry.

Desserts will be judged for a People's Choice Award beginning at 5:00 p.m.

The public will pay for their meal and receive one voting ticket per plate. The ticket can be placed in the box representing the dessert of their choice.

Winners will be announced following the cook-off. Serving will take place until 6:30 p.m. or until an entrée is gone.
